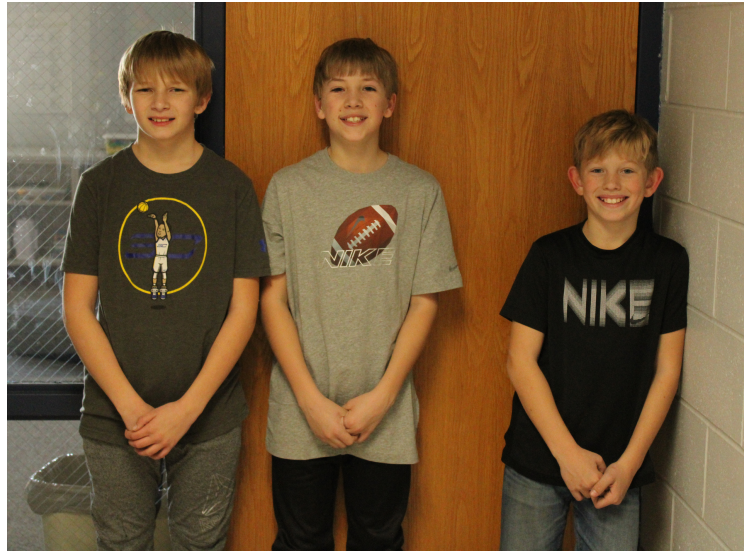
TC YOUTH WRESTLERS
